On motion by Councilman Stycos, seconded by Councilman Archetto, it was voted to override the Mayor's veto of the Revenues, Police #2801-45113, Other Revenue – Park Meters in the amount of \$5,000. Motion failed on a vote of 1-8. The following being recorded as voting "aye": Councilman Stycos -1. The following being recorded as voting "nay": Councilwoman Luciano, Councilmen Donahue, Navarro, Archetto, Santamaria, Favicchio, Council Vice-President Pelletier and Council President Lupino -8.
