**Jean Lamb**, 71 Vinton Ave., appeared to represent the Oaklawn neighborhood and addressed the issue of the noise.

**Jerome Burn**, 81 Vinton Ave., appeared to speak and stated that this business owner is not a good neighbor. He has been told over and over again of the problems. The neighbors have been getting lip service from him for years.

**Art Lamb**, 71 Vinton Ave., appeared to speak and stated that there is a petition with not too many signatures because people are getting tired of these issues.

**Mr. Cataldi** stated that the business is closed most of the holidays. He would like to know if he is breaking any laws because if he is not, then he will not do anything and stay the way he is. He will look into a solution.

On motion by Council Minority Leader Favicchio, seconded by Councilwoman Lee, it was voted to continue this item for one month and have applicant look into technology that pleases everyone.
