Under Discussion:

Councilman Aceto asked if there would not be enough time to have a Traffic Engineer's Report by the Council meeting. Solicitor Kirshenbaum stated that the Traffic Engineer has 90 days to report. Hopefully, there will be a report by then, but out of abundance of caution, he suggested continuing this Ordinance as amended.

Motion and second were withdrawn.

On motion by Councilman Botts, seconded by Councilman Farina, it was voted to continue this Ordinance as amended. Motion passed unanimously.
