**Officer Henry** gave report of the Jun 25, 2015 incident and stated that Mr. Reedy met with the Colonel regarding some problems at this establishment. His client would like to work with the Police Department as to implementing the use of plastic cups because his client does not agreed to this due to the fact that he does not like to serve wine in plastic cups.

**Council Minority Leader Favicchio** asked how many bouncers this establishment has. Mr. Reedy stated, 14 on Friday and Saturday nights and they patrol outside as well. **Councilman Farina** stated that Providence requires bouncer training and they should look into that program.
