

(The following is not a verbatim transcript of comments or discussion that occurred during the meeting, but rather a summarization intended for general informational purposes. All motions and votes are the official records).

TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was held on Monday, March 21, 2016 in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Cranston, Rhode Island.

CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 P.M. by the Chair.

MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:

On motion by Mr. Raisner, seconded by Mr. Carabitses, it was voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting and they stand approved as recorded. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

- *Update from Administration regarding list of hot spot streets to be submitted to DOT for their Assessment Test. (Cont. 8/17/2015, 9/21/2015 & 10/19/2015)*

Mr. Barone stated that a report has been submitted to the City by RIDOT last week and the City has not had a chance to review it yet. There is a meeting scheduled for March 23rd.

On motion by Mr. Raisner, seconded by Mr. Keith, it was voted to continue this item to the next meeting to give the City a chance to review this report and Mr. Barone to report back to the Committee.

PUBLIC HEARING/NEW BUSINESS:

- *Presentation from RedFlex regarding monitoring and deterring drivers who illegally pass school buses*

No one was present. This item was continued.

- *Presentation by Sensys America regarding automated red light camera enforcement*

Rick Ledford, Sales Director, appeared to give a presentation on automated enforcement, not just automated red lights, but also speeding in school zones. The company is originally located in Orlando, Florida and their technology is in more than 20 countries. The systems are red light, mobile speed and fixed speed. He stated that the company running the red light program in Providence is terrible.

Mr. Ledford stated that he has met with the Mayor and Mr. Coupe, Director of Administration, regarding this program and they are very much impressed and he also spoke to the Chief of Police who is also very much in favor of this.

Mr. Ledford stated that the difference between a Police Officer issuing a ticket and this program issuing the ticket is if the Police issue a ticket, it would affect the driver's insurance and their driving record, where this program does not. This program is designed to change drivers' driving behavior. The ticket issued by the company is a civil penalty.

Councilman Paplauskas questioned who owns the video from the cameras. Mr. Ledford stated that the City would own the videos and the videos are kept up to seven years, which is statute of limitations. The video starts to run only when a prediction of violation is going to happen. He indicated that there is pending legislation to have these cameras placed just in school zones for speeding. They would be placed one quarter of a mile from a school. If this legislation passes, they could not be placed in residential areas.

Mr. Barone stated that the biggest issue and complaints he receives as Constituent Affairs Director is speeding in residential areas. He would like to know what the decrease in accidents and decrease in speeding is in the communities who have this system and since they installed this system and pre-camera installation has the number of violations gone down. He stated that speeding becomes the issue and not red lights.

Mr. Carabitses stated that, to him, this system seems to be more of a money grabber than deterring drivers from running a red light.

Mr. Barone asked Mr. Ledford if he does any studies of how many violations were issued at a certain location. Mr. Ledford stated, yes. He indicated that the only cost to the City for this program is the Officers' cost to review the videos. The units are paid for by the violators. He also indicated that violators can access zerofatality.com website and view their video once they receive their ticket and then decide if they still want to go to Municipal Court or just pay the ticket.

Sgt. Needham asked if the City would be given a certain amount of time to promote the system. Mr. Ledford stated that there would be a 30-day warning period and signage would be installed 30 feet before the unit.

Mr. Ledford stated that he has been advised that the Bill for speed system in school zones should be voted on in the Senate this week.

Mr. Keith asked if the pending Bill deals just with public schools or also for daycares. Mr. Ledford stated that it deals with all schools where children are present.

Mr. Ledford stated that he would be willing to do a study for the City for free if they would like.

- ***Crosswalk Alert System – Phenix Ave. and Atwood Ave. near Stop and Shop***

Chair stated that there was a near fatal pedestrian accident recently on Phenix Ave. near Stop and Shop. He asked Administration if there is some kind of an alert system that can be installed in that spot or if there is something else the City can do to make this area a little safer. Mr. Barone stated that last time he checked with the Police Department, that accident was still under investigation and at the time, there was no sign of speeding or alcohol and no summonses issued. He can state that the crosswalk sign and post there is illuminated.

Chair stated that he would like to see a traffic report of any accidents at this location for the past few years. He would like this information, if possible, for the next Council meeting.

On motion by Chairman Santamaria, seconded by Mr. Keith, it was voted to continue this item to the next meeting and have Mr. Barone report back on any information he can obtain. Motion passed unanimously.

- **Resolution Traffic Safety Report on Gladstone Street School Vicinity (Referred from 1/25/16 City Council) [\[click to view\]](#)**

Chair stated that he is not in favor of speed bumps. He asked that Mr. Barone provide a report to Council Majority Leader Archetto, who had asked for this a few months ago, and he will address this at the next Council meeting. Mr. Barone stated that he has a report and will give it to the Clerk. He also stated that there are some things that could be put in place, mostly to do with dropping kids off at the Gladstone St. school area. As to speed bumps, there are a number of reasons why they are not good, one being, they would decrease response time with emergency vehicles. Another reason would be they would become a problem with plowing streets during the winter.

Chair stated that this Resolution will be referred back to Council Majority Leader Archetto for further study with the Public Works Department.

- **Resolution Speed Bumps on Laurel Hill Avenue from Argyle Street to Oxford Street (Referred from 1/25/16 City Council) [\[click to view\]](#)**

On motion by Chairman Santamaria, seconded by Mr. Keith, it was voted to not recommend speed bumps at this location. Motion passed unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

Chair asked Sgt. Needham to the Committee an update regarding the CARE Program.

Sgt. Needham stated that since July's inception of this program, there have been over 1,500 violations issued and 1,476 contacts; overnight parking detail has been implemented. There have been 40 unfilled CARE details and 26 extra details. He also stated that September was the busiest month and December was the slowest month.

Next meeting was scheduled for Monday, May16, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
