
Chair stated that since the applicant is present, if there are no objections, the committee will hear this but will be voted on at next month's meeting as ratification. No one objected.

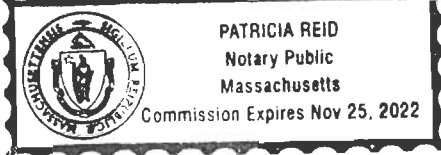
