1-18-02 Ordinance in amendment of Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Cranston, 2005, entitled "Zoning" (Change of Zone - 350 Park Avenue. Petition filed by Park East Realty, Inc. Cont. 4/12/2018.

On motion by Council Vice-President Favicchio, seconded by Councilman Colford, it was voted to amend this Ordinance as follows: Line #28 add: "those permitted by right in a C-2 Zoning District and C-3 Zoning District limited to 1. Commercial Daycare and 2. Urgent Care Facility. Delete "C-3"; add "Lots 160, 167 and 168 on Zoning Plat 4/4 located on the southerly side of Park Avenue between Mill Street and Sunset Terrace".

Roll call was taken on above motion and motion passed unanimously.

On motion by Council Vice-President Favicchio, seconded by Councilman Colford, it was voted to recommend approval of the above Ordinance as amended. Motion passed unanimously.
