

## **SAFETY SERVICES & LICENSES COMMITTEE**

### **II. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING :**

On motion by Councilman Barone, seconded by Councilman Navarro, it was voted to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last meeting and they stand approved as recorded. Motion passed unanimously.

### **III. CORRESPONDENCE:** Letter from Dunkin Donuts 630 Reservoir Avenue Re: Restrictions

**Norbert Zwiener** appeared to speak and stated that he is asking for removal of restriction regarding "Police security between 11:00 P.M. and 3:00 A.M." He has not had any problems at this location. Major Blackmar stated that the Police Department has no problem removing this restriction. No one appeared to oppose.

**Vincent Martucci** appeared to speak and stated that by the end of May, all the work should be completed. Chief Delgado indicated that the inspection was done March 12, 2004 and they have been given four extensions. He will contact the State Fire Marshall to see if they will give an extension until the end of May, but he cannot make any guarantees. Council President Garabedian asked Mr. Martucci how much he has spent on this project since 2004. Mr. Martucci stated \$150,000 and still climbing. Chair asked if outside tent has been inspected by the Fire Department and Building Inspector and asked that Mr. Martucci check with the Inspector's Office to see if he needs a permit for the tent.

Councilman Barone asked that the applicant be asked to appear at the June meeting to give a status update.

Chair referred to the Solicitor's opinion, which was presented this evening prior to this meeting. Councilman Navarro stated that he has filed for an Ethics Commission opinion on this matter and he has not received an opinion yet from them. Because of this, he asked that this item be tabled in order for him to speak regarding this matter if the Ethics Commission does not find a conflict with him speaking on this issue.

Councilman Barone motioned to approve this license renewal. No one seconded this motion.

Council Member Bucci asked if this Committee approves this license renewal this evening, would the Ethics Commission's decision effect our decision on that. Solicitor stated, no, he does not think it would.

Major Blackmar appeared to speak and stated that the bidding process was waived for purchasing police vehicles at auctions and he started attending the auctions with Gerard Scotti, of Vehicle Maintenance and they have been able to purchase the same vehicles in a competitive bid. They have used the Blue Book to bid on vehicles. They have been able to save between \$1,500 to \$2,000 at minimum wholesale.

Councilman Navarro stated that he would like to know where these savings, that are being stated, are coming from. Councilman Barone called a "point of order", and indicated that Councilman Navarro stated earlier that he was waiting for an opinion from the Ethics Commission and he does not think he is doing that. Chair stated that, as Chair, he does not want to see Councilman Navarro or anyone on this Council get in trouble with the Ethics Commission and he is asked Councilman Navarro to be very careful on how he addresses this issue.

Councilman Barone stated that every vehicle purchased at auction were presented to the Board of Contract and Purchase.

Councilman Lupino stated that, in reading the Solicitor's opinion, he has a problem with the Purchasing Agent stating savings not knowing what they are going to pay for the vehicle ahead of time. He questioned how the Purchasing Agent can know beforehand what the savings to the City are going to be. He asked Major Blackmar if he has written approval from the Purchasing Agent and Majority member of the Board of Contract and Purchase. Major Blackmar stated that before going to auctions, he and Gerard Scotti appear before the Board of Contract and Purchase and they advise the Board exactly how many vehicles they are going to purchase and they obtain approval from the Board to go to the auction.
