An incident occurred at his home last week where there were approximately five teenagers, whom his neighbor saw since he was not home. One of the teenagers went into his yard and the Police was called and they let the teenagers go without calling their parents. He is concerned with Officer Nery, and feels it is reverse discrimination. There have been a lot of robberies unfolding in the City and there was an incident last week at Bain Middle School involving a gang. He does not want his neighborhood to have these types of problems. Since the Police Station relocated, his neighbors have formed a crime watch group.

**Chair** stated that he spoke to Commander Lynch prior to the meeting and Commander Lynch asked that Mr. Ricci call him tomorrow and he will look into this to see what needs to be done to address his concerns.

**Chair** stated that the discussion and vote for Renewal of the liquor license will be incorporated with the transfer.

**John DiBona, Esq.**, appeared to represent the transferor and **John Bolton, Esq.**, appeared to represent the transferee.

**Councilman Livingston** questioned if sale of liquor license is permitted. Solicitor Garganese stated that the Statute refers to transfer of liquor license and does not mention sale, but he would have to research this.

**Chair** stated that the question is whether applicant is purchasing the business or the liquor license and the City Clerk is obtaining a copy of the Statute to review. Solicitor reviewed this portion of the Statute and quoted Section 3-5-29 and stated that liquor license can be transferred according to this provision and does not authorize sale of license except for under Section 3-5-19. If the Committee is speaking of sale of just the license, he is not prepared to comment on this at this time and would need time to research this.

**Kelly Coates**, representing Carpionato, appeared to speak and indicated on maps of where this business will be located. He stated that it will be to the right of the existing Bombay Store. It will be operated by Carpionato employee and it will be a totally different type of operation and it is at a different end of the market. His company has nothing to do with the transferor.

**Michael Sepe**, 95 Massachusetts St., appeared to speak and stated that the City should have the right to issue the liquor license, since the business has been closed for three months and the liquor license should have reverted back to the City.

**Frank Fiorenzano**, Property Manager for Cranston BVT Associates, LP, appeared to speak and stated that in dealing with the renewal application, there is no such place of where this license is housed. He showed pictures from a camera of the site where there is an empty building. He questioned how can a renewal be approved, since there is no place and there is nothing there, it is an empty building. When transferor first obtained the liquor license, he questioned if it was intended to be a chain, if that was the case, the license was given under false pretenses. Mr. Fiorenzano stated that Paolino Properties is owed over \$100,000 by the transferor and \$6,000 in Real Estate taxes that have been paid by Paolino Properties. He asked that the Committee take under advisement whether there was a valid transfer from the beginning and asked that the renewal and the transfer be continued for one month in order to get more answers to the questions addressed this evening.
