You are hereby notified that the Cranston City Plan Commission will be hosting a special workshop on the City's anticipated Solar Farm Ordinance. This public meeting will be held on Monday, May 13th, 2019, beginning @ 5:30 P.M. in the main auditorium of the William Hall Library, 1825 Broad Street. Cranston residents as well as the general public are invited to attend and participate in this discussion. Light refreshments will be served.

The City Planning Department will begin the workshop with a brief presentation to provide context for the discussion. The City Plan Commission will lead the workshop, allowing time for the public and stakeholders to comment. Due to the complexity of this issue, it is anticipated that individual speaking time may be limited in order to allow as many attendees as possible the opportunity to speak. For this reason, it is strongly encouraged that you submit comments & questions in writing to the City Planning Department (jpezzullo@cranstonri.org) at any time before or after the workshop.

This workshop is intended to inform the first draft of the forthcoming ordinance which will be publicly presented by staff at the June 4th regular City Plan Commission meeting. This ongoing process will include several more opportunities for the public to voice their opinion on the overall direction of the ordinance. The City requests and appreciates the ongoing input and involvement from the public in this important process.
