## 2018 CRANSTON NEIGHBORHOOD TREE PLANTING PROGRAM

A partnership between the City of Cranston and the RI Tree Council

FREE trees for planting on private property are now available to Cranston residents who meet program eligibility requirements. The trees are between 8-10 feet tall with a 4-6 foot crown spread. They will be furnished and installed in spring 2018 (April 1 – May 30) at **no cost to the home-owner**. That's a \$250 value!!

To be eligible for the free trees, individuals must:

- Own the property where the tree is to be planted
- Agree to install the tree on their property within 25 feet of the public right-of-way
- Complete a Consent and Waiver of Liability Form
- Complete a My Tree Selection Form

**There are ONLY 40 trees\*** available for the spring 2018 campaign, so don't lose out on this great opportunity. The 2018 Cranston Neighborhood Tree Planting Program is being supported with funding provided by the City of Cranston. The RI Tree Council (aka: RITree) a non-profit organization, has been selected by the City of Cranston to administrate the program. The program purpose is to plant shade trees on private property where they have the greatest chance for survival and long-term contribution to the community.
